

BRANCH AND CLUSTER SUPPORT

Stem Holder, 560sh

When growers grow additional side shoots (heads), it significantly adds to the trellising costs and labor. Also, lack of proper plant support leads to loss of additional produce and the lower clusters rest on the ground and rot.

The Stem Holder is used during the growing period (usually around the third month) to attach the extra shoot to the main stem, saving the need for an additional hook or twine.

Advantages

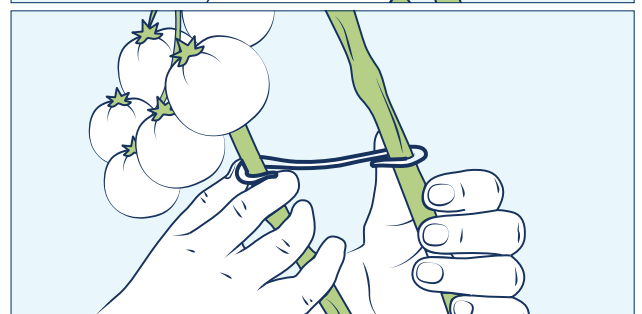
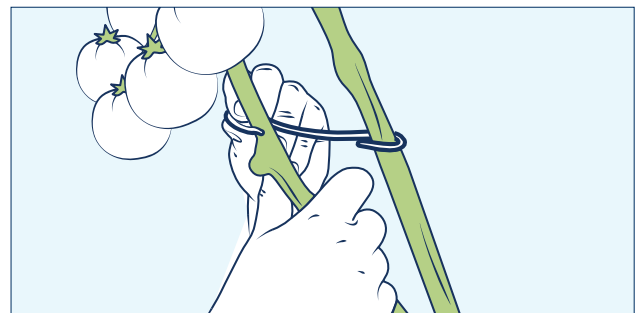
Efficient labor

- Attaches quickly and easily to the main stem
- Increases yield on additional branches
- One stem holder costs less than a single tomato
- No twine needed
- Eliminates the need to purchase an extra metal hook (mainly for short season)
- Flexible and strong
- Easy to remove and adjust
- Multi-seasonal

Crop protection

- Prevents the additional branches from bending and breaking
- Prevents stem damage
- Prevents the plant from growing wild and blocking ventilation
- Supports parallel stems
- Protects lower clusters from ground contact

* Stem Holders can be also used for cluster support.



Instructions for use

- Connect the two stems together with the stem holder
